The **Kick-off meeting** of the project **ADRIACLIM** - *Climate change information, monitoring and management tools for adaptation strategies in Adriatic coastal areas* - was held on June 29th and 30th. Due to specific situation, the Kick off metting was organized online.

AdriaClim is the acronym of the new research project funded by the **Italy-Croatia Interreg Cooperation Programme** that is dedicated to supporting the development of science-based regional and local climate change adaptation plans.
