To become effective, following decisions of the Joint Monitoring Committee shall be followed up on with administrative decrees by the involved authorities, which will be published in the related websites, in compliance with the national legislation.

Item 1 decision:

The JMC approves the agenda of the sixth JMC meeting.

Item 2 decision:

The JMC approves the thematic projects with the conditions and the new project partners, which are specified in the basis for JMC decision for each project, which is an integral part of this decision.

The JMC approves the projects with the minimum budget reductions specified in the following tables.

In the subsidy contract the project partners shall ensure to cover the overbooking amount, in case savings in PA 1 are not available in the future, or for Italy the two regions shall confirm in writing to cover it.

For normal projects, maximum 5 partners are admissible, at least one from Albania, one from Montenegro, one from Puglia and one from Molise.

No additional points shall be given for Social Partners and NGOs' participation.

The Joint Steering Committee shall have the right to give up to 20 points with justification.

Limitation for Universities shall be made at Faculty Level for Albania and for other countries as applicable.

Item 6 decision:

The JMC approves that the seventh JMC meeting shall take place in Italy - Molise, in venue to be confirmed, on 14-15 May 2019. It commits not to change the date, except for cases of force majeur.
